## Objectives

Upon completion of this course you will be able to:

- Identify and classify dangerous goods
- Interpret hazard communication
- Detect hidden dangerous goods in cargo and mail
- Check documentation and packages for indications of undeclared dangerous goods
- Explain the basic Emergency Response procedures

## Target Audience

- Airport or ground handling staff involved in screening baggage, cargo and mail
- Security service providers staff involved in screening baggage, cargo and mail
- Security operations managers and supervisors

## Pre-requisites

- Recommended level is Entry-level and Intermediate
- The recommended level of language proficiency is ICAO Operational Level 4 or the equivalent

## Key Topics

- Understanding the basics of dangerous goods
- Recognizing dangerous goods
- Indicators within documentation or packages of undeclared dangerous goods
- Report dangerous goods accidents

## Delivery

- Classroom-based learning including lectures, exercises, case studies and final assessment

## Exam

The participant is required to score at least 80% to pass the mastery test.

## Certificate Awarded

The participant will be awarded with a GAA - IATA completion certificate upon successful completion of the course.
