

E-Learning Course Pilot Incapacitation

Program Overview

Pilot incapacitation training requirements should include Theoretical Training every 12 months and can form part of the recurrent training, and Practical training should be carried out every 3 years in an approved FSTD. This course includes types of incapacitation and how to deal with them, recognition, The Two Communication Rule, and how to assist other crew members.
