

E-Learning Course Multi-Crew Cooperation

Program Overview

Multi-crew cooperation (MCC) is a training course that allows aircraft pilots to fly multi-crew aircraft. It is a requirement before a pilot may undertake a multi-crew aircraft type rating.

Course Content

The program of training will include the following:

- → Module (1): Introduction, Communication, Leadership and Teamwork, Pilot Incapacitation.
- → Module (2): Situational Awareness, Stress and Fatigue, Environment, Weather and ATC.
- → Module (3): Work Management, problem solving and decision making, Task sharing, Monitoring, and cross checking.
- → Module (4): Standard Phraseology, Aircraft manuals, Checklist and briefing, Normal procedures.
